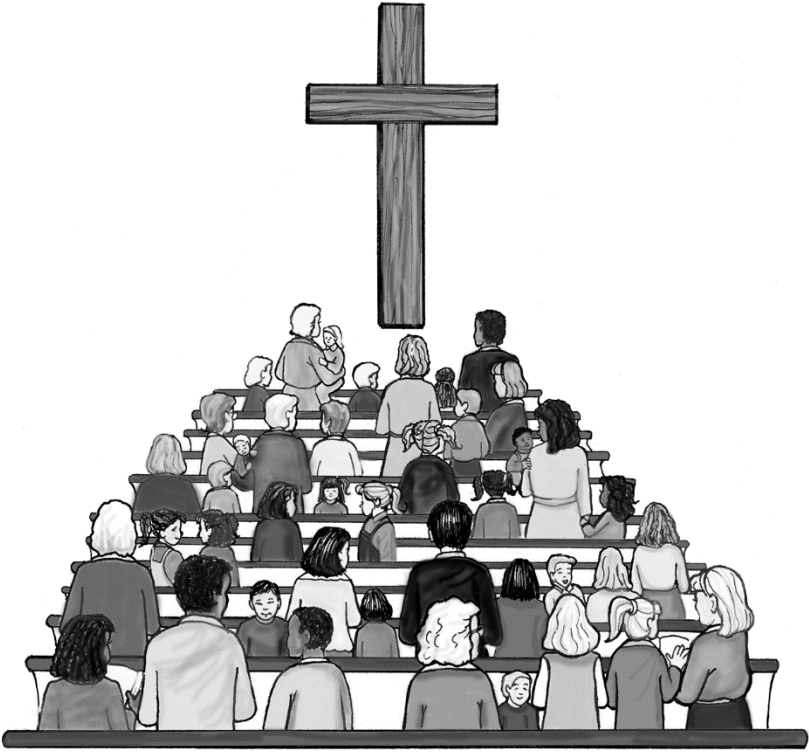

The Israelites had 3 different harvests!

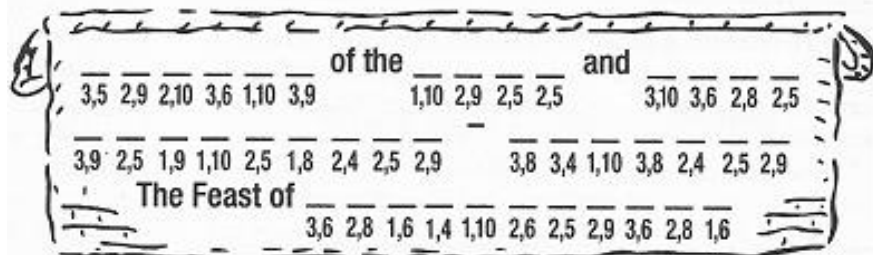
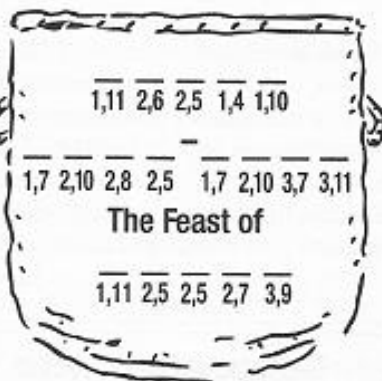
God told them how to celebrate feasts at the time of each harvest.
