Bible Travelers

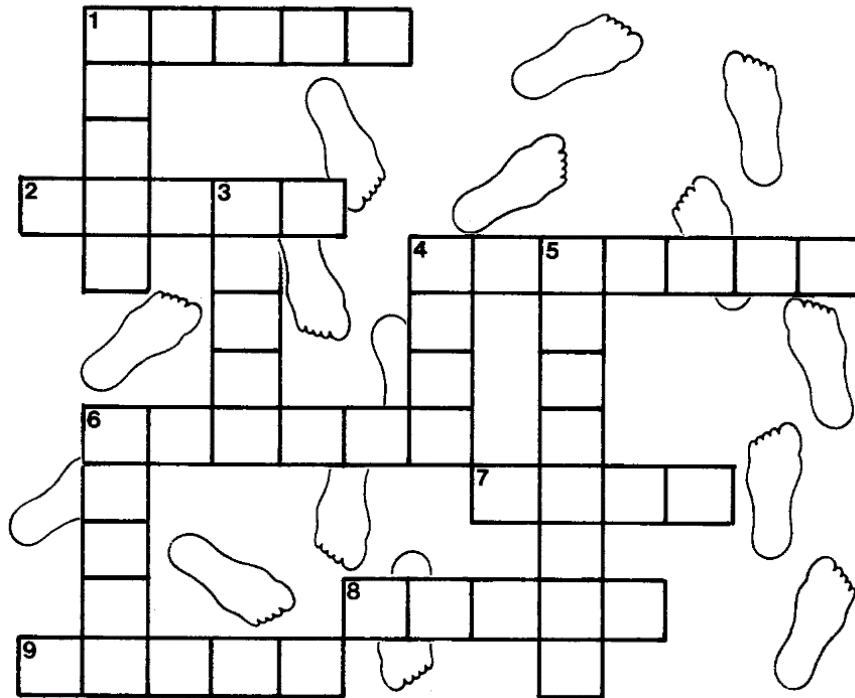
People in Bible times traveled for some very special reasons. Can you put the right answers in the right blocks?
